

I can remember, on more than one occasion, my mother saying to me as a child and a teenager, when I was wanting to compromise in some area, "That's NOT how we do

it at our house!" She was trying to call me out of my wrong thinking, my weak thinking, my wishful thinking and into a right way of thinking and behaving. I also remember that I didn't like it so much then. But I do now! The Holy Spirit is a wonderful teacher and counselor helping us all mature and live in Christ.

Like Paul said in 1 Corinthians 13:11. *"When I was a child I thought like a child,*



reasoned like a child. But the day came when I matured, and I set aside my childish ways." Paul calls believers to come higher! Over and over he admonished every church, every individual to **remember who we are in Christ.** To choose our actions through Christ - remembering what we can do through Him, because of His strength and new life flowing in us.

Jesus said it this way, **"I am the vine** and you are the branches..." The Passion Translation gives a beautiful window onto what Jesus is declaring: "I am the sprouting vine and you're my branches. **As you live in union with me as your source, fruitfulness will stream from** within you — but when you live separated from me you are powerless." (John 15:5 TPT)

This is how we do it at our house! In the <u>House of God, in the family of the Father</u> we do our lives in connection with Jesus. You're not on your own. You have Him, His Word, and His Holy Spirit in you.

In fact Hebrews 13:5 tells us that to let our lives be without covetousness (don't look at all the bad news in the world and wish you were somewhere else — OR someone else!!), "be content... because He has said, 'I will never leave you or forsake you.'" This is what I want to center up on today and EN-courage you. Have courage to be you, the you that you are

because of your life IN Jesus Christ.

This passage of scripture gives that hope that will anchor your soul - your mind, your will, your emotions. Hebrews 13:6 goes on to say that since God has said He will never leave you on your own (vs 5), now "So we may boldly say, the Lord is my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me."

My late husband, Don Gossett, wrote a short but powerful book called "Say It With Boldness." It is very important to note that we do not hide from what's going

ROIL 8:37 8:37 HIM WHO LON It is estimated that there are about 7000 promises by God that He has given us in His Word. He is constantly saying what He will do. So our theme for life can simply be: "Because God has said it - that means I have permission to boldly say." In fact when we read God's Word He instructs us to agree with Him and proclaim out loud.

God has said, so I may boldly say.

Then say the scripture of His promise of healing, love, relationship with Him, family members helped, provision, peace... remember there are 7000!

This courage to walk with God is recorded throughout the Bible. Another passage is found in 1 Kings 8:56 says: "Because he has boldly spoken, we know we can declare it boldly; it will be as He said because, 'There has not failed one word of all His good promise, which he promised.""

Let me give you a taste of what's in store for you in Don's book: Say It With Boldness. You can set yourself to live boldly by the Bible. Don put it this way:

"This is the secret of Bold Bible living: Remember who you are! Learn to respect what God has placed within you. Read the Bible to learn who you are in Christ.

"One of my favorite sayings is this one: when you were born again, you were not born to be defeated; you were

> born to conquer.' I believe that Romans 8:37 tells us, 'No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.'

"We are more than conquerors! We are children of God, dear to Him, and join theirs with Christ. We have great riches in Jesus! We are heirs of all things. We are who God made us to be.

"We are a branch of the living Vine, for Jesus said, 'I am the vine, you are the branches" (John 15:5). We are the temple of the living God, for the Bible says, 'You are the temple of the living God; as God has said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people' (2 Corinthians 6:16).

"What can we do in Christ?

"We can do all things, whatsoever needs to be accomplished. The Lord gives us the ability to do all He commands of us so that we can say with Paul, 'I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me' (Philippians 4:13).

"What do we have in Christ?

"We have life, we have light, we have power, we have peace, we have provision for our needs, we have all things that pertain to life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3). Yes, to be a Christian is more than just being

a forgiven sinner. We are heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ

Jesus; we are linked with God by the new birth; and we are partakers of His very nature. No wonder we can sing and shout and be glad today, when we know what it really means to be a child of God!

"Just remember who you are right in the midst of your battles. Don't accept defeat. Defeat may

come and stare you right in the face. Refuse to accept it! ...

One of His greatest promises is of being able to have intimate conversation and fellowship with God.

to enter the holiest by the blood of Jesus (Hebrews 10:19)."




into prisons. People are valuable everywhere on this earth. Thank you so much for your prayers and donations. We can do this together with God's power and leading!


