- 1 The Lord is the strength of my **MIND**, so today I think sound healthy thoughts. I think upon those things that are true, honest, just, pure, lovely and of a good report. A strong mind is a positive mind, the mind of Christ. *"I have the mind of Christ."* 1 Corinthians 2:16.
- 2 The Lord is the strength of my EARS, so I hear well today. Seven times in Revelation 2 & 3 the command comes, "He that hath an ear, let him heart what the Spirit saith" Most importantly, with my renewed, sound, strong mind, I hear what the Spirit saith unto me.

- 7 The Lord is the strength of every **ORGAN, TISSUE, BONE, FIBER, NERVE** and **CELL** in my body. The Lord is the strength of my life from the top of my head to the soles of my feet.
- 8 The Lord is the strength of my LIFE my whole life – spirit, soul and body. He infuses strength into the hidden man of the heart.
- 9 My affirmations for today: Daniel 11:32, "The people that know their God shall be strong and do exploits."
